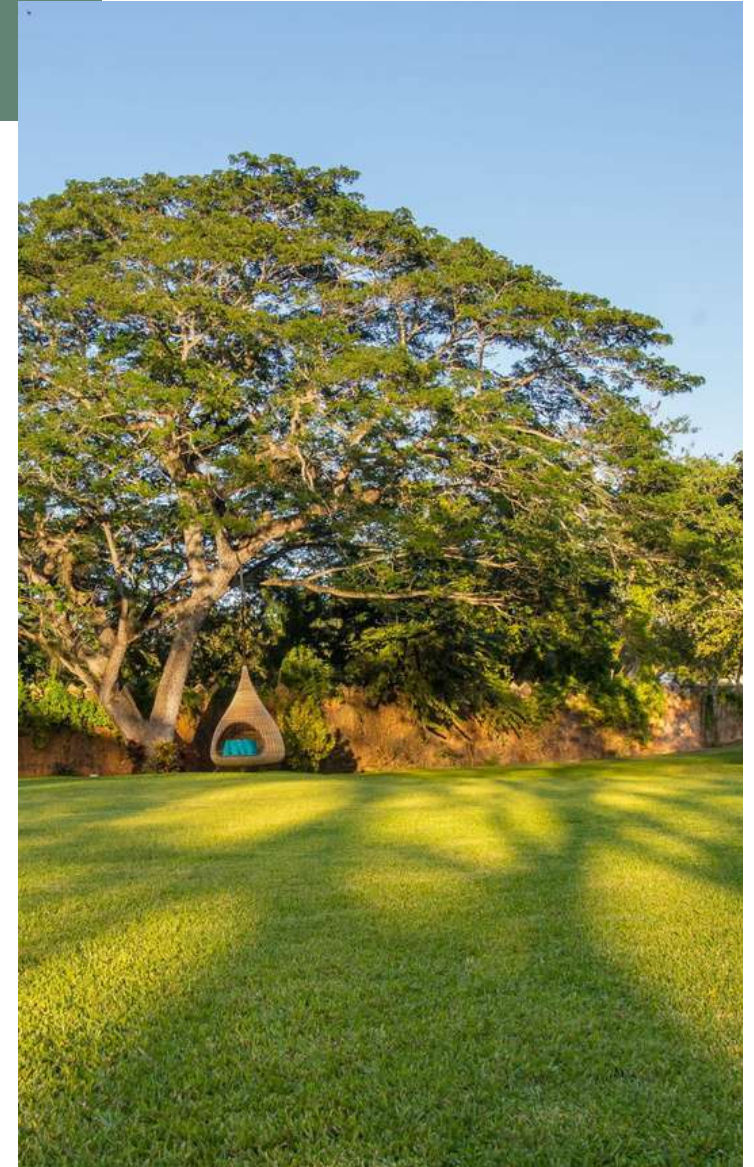
In order for the tourism and travel industry to continue thriving for years to come, it is essential to prioritize sustainable and responsible planning and management.

Each Chablé Hotel is designed with great attention to detail, utilizing the natural landscape and orientation of the land. We carefully consider renewable building materials to create spaces that prioritize a direct connection with nature.

The project for Chablé Yucatán utilized rescued materials from the 16th century hacienda buildings, repurposing collapsed stones, consolidating other buildings, and structuring the casitas and villas with the least environmental impact possible. In its interior design, roots, and trunks of fallen trees were reinterpreted as unique furniture, used in their original organic beauty in different rooms and spaces of the hacienda.

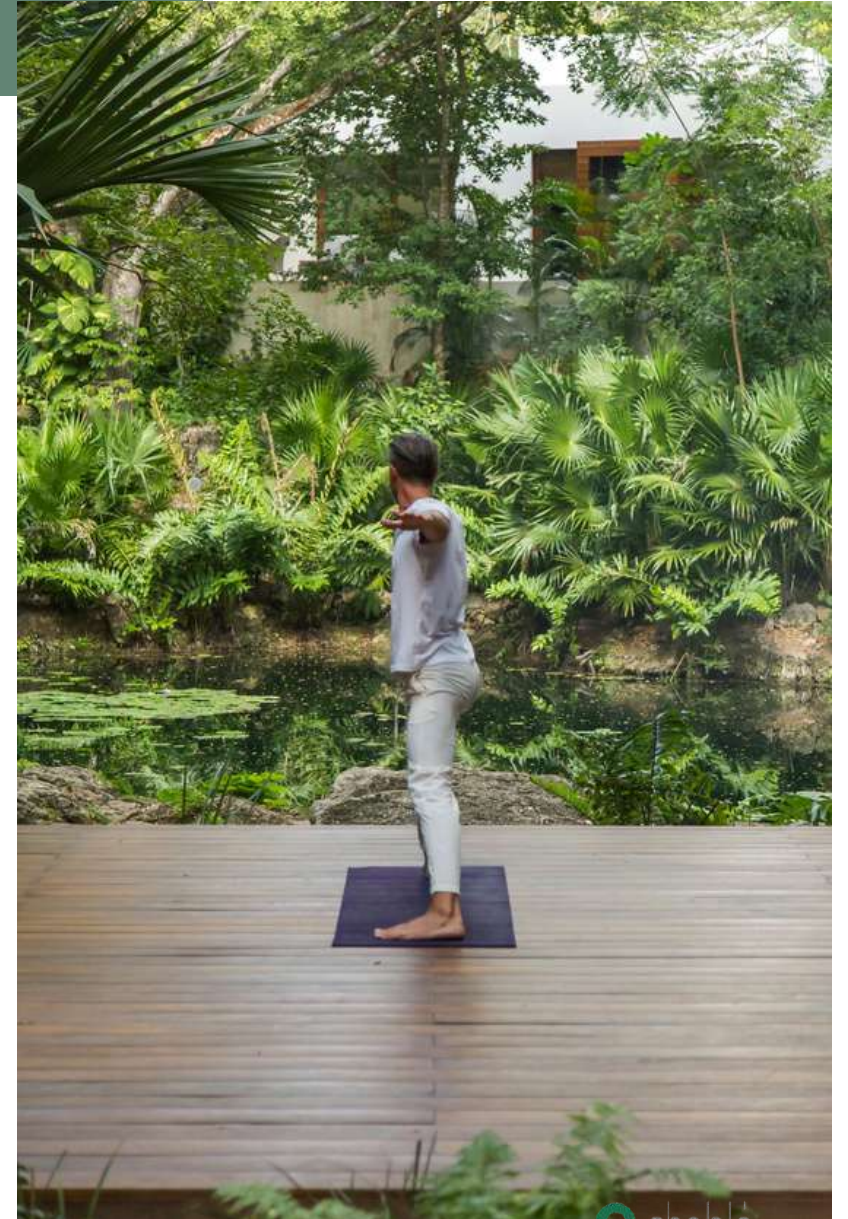

We have prioritized the following global goals that are most relevant to our pledge:

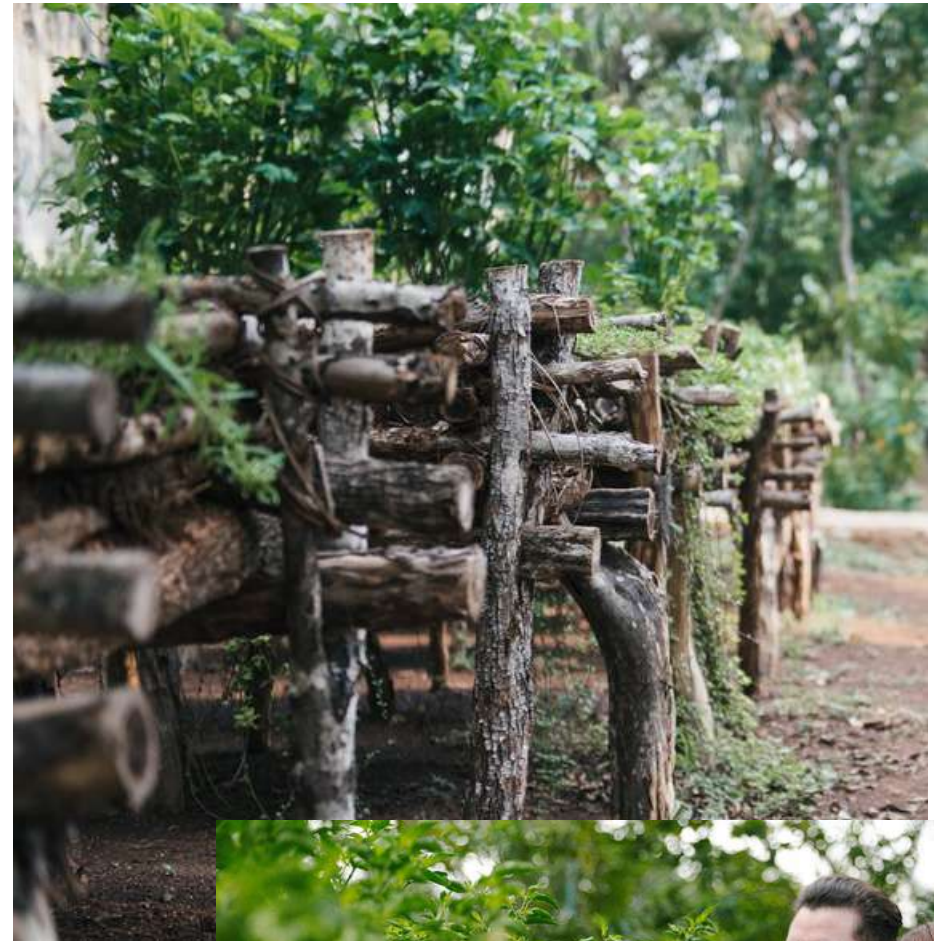


FARM TO TABLE

At Chablé Yucatán, we take great pride in our commitment to preserving traditional Mayan farming techniques. We have over 100 Ka'anche's - traditional Mayan gardens - where we carefully recreate these ancient harvesting methods, some of which have not been used in over a century. In addition, we also have production beds on the ground, which measure up to 20 square meters each.

Our Ka'anche's are home to a variety of products, including radish, coriander, oregano, basil, citronella, stevia, chives, cherry tomato, habañoero pepper, and many others. We use these ingredients to produce a wide range of culinary delights in-house, including mayonnaise, ice cream, sorbets, salty and sweet bread, tortillas, jams, sauces, granola, mole, amaranth, chocolate truffles, and crowbars.

By utilizing these traditional farming techniques and sourcing ingredients locally, we are able to provide our guests with the freshest, most flavorful meals possible while also supporting the local community and preserving important cultural traditions.



WILDLIFE CONSERVATION

Chablé Yucatán's mission is centered on the conservation of wildlife. We are committed to protecting and preserving the populations of white-tailed deer, armadillos and melipona bees; which are essential to the local ecosystem.



PLASTIC FREE

We eliminated use of plastic bottles, saving more than 7,000 a month.

Purification and bottling of Chablé water in glass bottles (3,375 liters per month in 4,500 glass bottles).

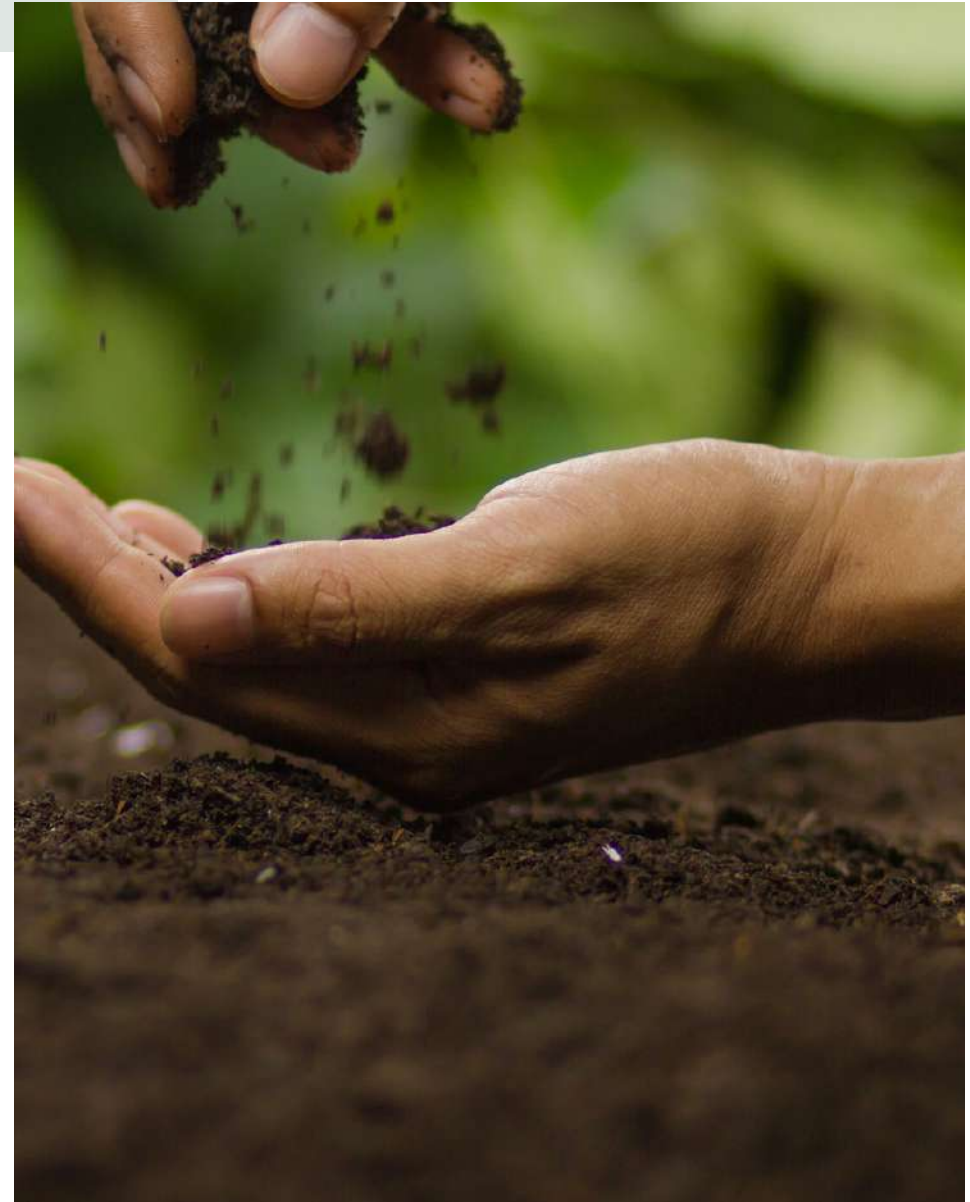
We use ecofriendly products in the rooms and we use bamboo as a substitute for plastic .



RECYCLING & WASTE

We create a natural substrate for our Ka'anches by utilizing grass and dried leaves. Additionally, we incorporate organic waste such as fruit peels and seeds from our Ki'ol and Ixi'im restaurants.

Our waste management system is highly controlled, with separate categories for organic, inorganic, plastic, glass, paper, and PET waste. We take extra care to properly dispose of hazardous waste and remove oils using established protocols.



SUSTAINABLE FISHING

Chablé Yucatán is proud to collaborate with sustainable fisheries that prioritize the well-being of aquatic species. We work with partners who are committed to maintaining a healthy balance in the ecosystem by adapting to the reproductive rates of fish and ensuring the survival of all species.

As part of our commitment to sustainability, our chefs and restaurants are active members of the "Pesca con Futuro" movement. This movement aims to spread a message of sustainability in fish and aquaculture production in Mexico, promoting responsible practices that keep aquatic populations at a healthy level.

On 2021, we installed solar panels at Chablé Yucatán, which generate 60% of the energy we currently use.

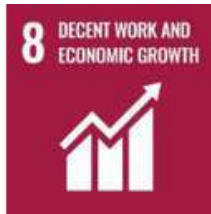


LOCAL EMPOWERMENT

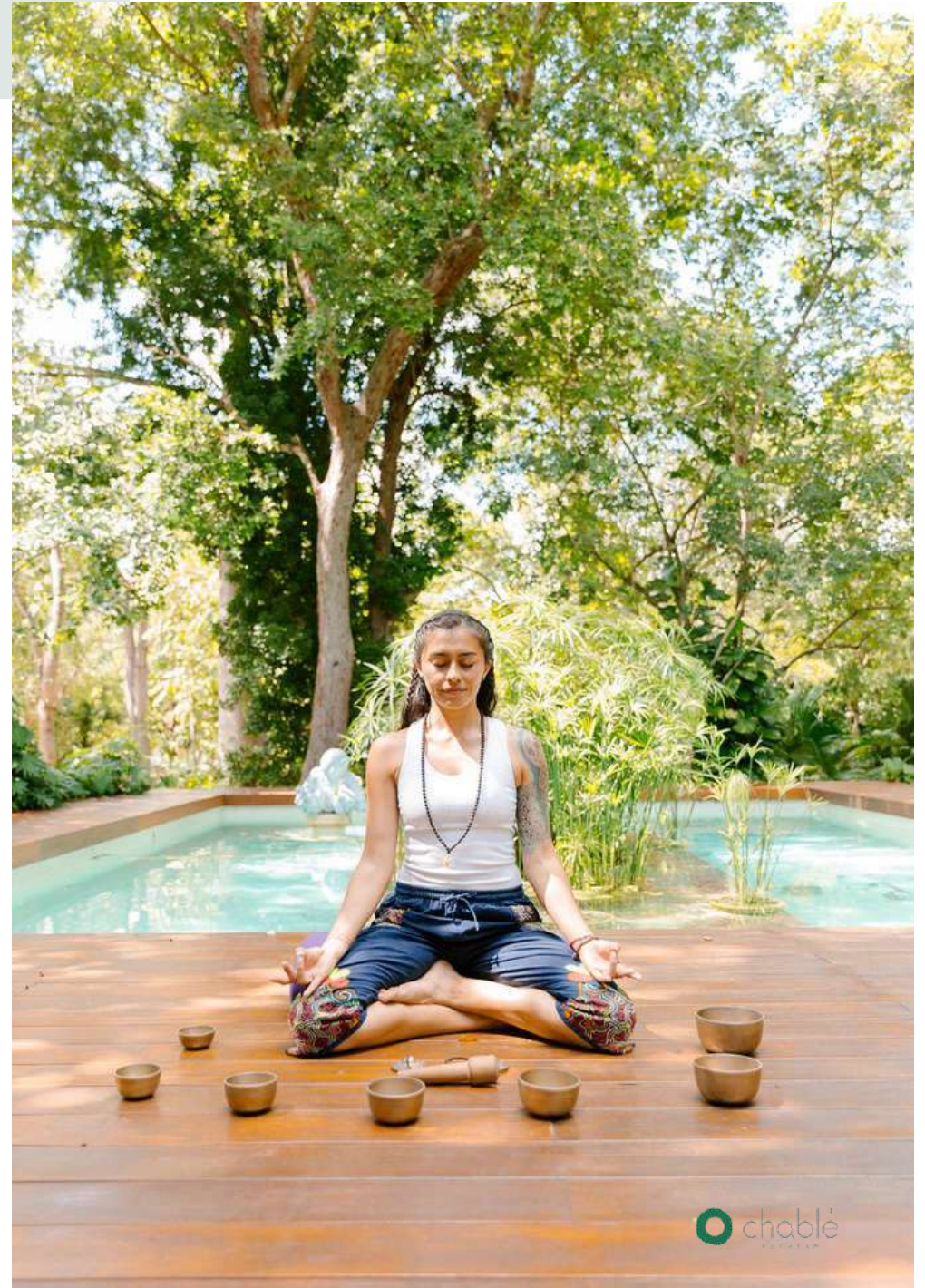

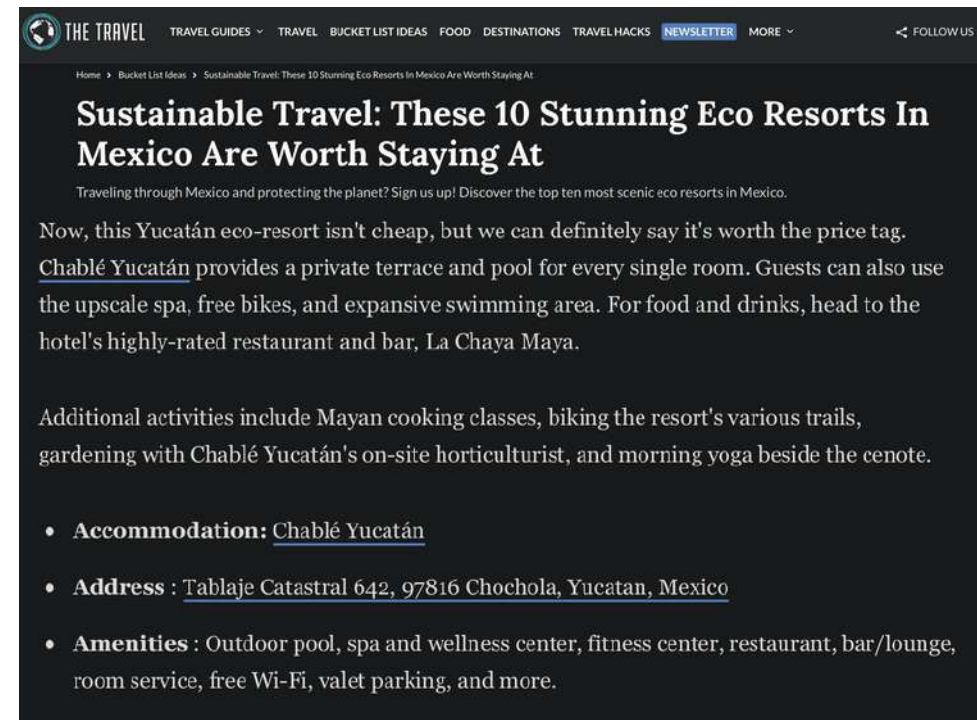
